New 250 watt-second Monolight from OPUS PRO

Opus Pro introduces new lighting: OPL-H250 monolight heads with a full range of accessories. A photographer can purchase a single head or a complete studio setup that fits in a padded carrying case. The OPL-H250 monolight is a self-contained strobe units that requires a standard 110v AC outlet. They are well constructed with a durable, all-metal housing and offer all the features you would expect from high-end lighting. The flash tube is daylight-balanced (5500K) and the light output is steplessly adjustable from 1/8 to full power (32 watt-seconds to 250 watt-seconds), plus each unit has a 60-watt, variable-power modeling light that has a separate on/off switch and is steplessly adjustable. Each monolight has a built-in photocell that can be triggered with another flash light source. You can turn the photocell off if you'd rather connect a sync cord into the standard 1/8" jack or use wireless remote trigger. At full power, the OPL-H250 monolight recharges in only 3 seconds. A readylight indicator illuminates when the flash capacitors are fully charged. Also, the photographer has the option of setting the unit to beep when fully charged.

Like all Opus and Opus Pro products, the OPL-H250 Monolight has undergone testing by an OSHA accredited laboratory to ensure that it meets or exceeds both UL and CSA safety standards. Additionally, these products are independently tested for reliability, durability, and safety before they are certified for field use in the USA and Canada.
